SURE ProEd operates entirely free of cost for students. There are no registration fees, no course fees, and no hidden expenses. 100% Online Training:

SURE ProEd delivers training entirely online, using platforms like Google Meet and GitHub to ensure seamless learning experiences. With the support of the Digital India movement and the

widespread reach of 4G/5G connectivity, even students in the most remote parts of the country can now access skill development right at their doorstep.

• Volunteer-Led:

All the trainers and mentors are working professionals from top companies like Intel, AMD, Apple, TCS, Cognizant, Western Digital, and more, who dedicate their personal time to teaching and mentoring.

• Hands-On Projects:

Each training culminates in real-world project work, giving students the confidence and portfolio they need to face interviews.

• Mentorship & Evaluation:

Weekly evaluations, assignments, GitHub submissions, and personal mentoring sessions help students stay on track.

Focus on Emerging Technologies:

Courses are offered in VLSI Design, Cybersecurity & Ethical Hacking, Full Stack Development, Java, Python, Physical Design, Data Structures, and more. By eliminating cost and providing high-quality mentorship, SURE ProEd offers equal opportunity access to some of the most in-demand technical domains of the present and future.

3. Scaling the Impact:

- Many women who had paused their careers are rejoining the workforce after undergoing the Cybersecurity or Full Stack Development internships or UI designing internships.

SURE ProEd's zero-cost model has inspired students to dream again this time, backed by skills, confidence, and a supportive community.

- Trainers and coordinators adhere to timelines, promoting a culture of punctuality and professionalism.


Discipline at SURE ProEd is not enforced with fear but inspired through accountability and example. This value instills workplace readiness in students and helps them thrive in industry environments.

SURE ProEd - Management Structures That Evolved with Time

Introduction:

A Mission-driven Organisation

SURE ProEd was born out of a divine vision and deep commitment to serving rural youth by bridging the skill gap in emerging technologies. What began as a volunteer-driven initiative with minimal structure has gradually evolved into a robust, purpose-led organization with streamlined processes, well-defined responsibilities, and a deeply committed leadership and volunteer base. The transformation in the management structure over the last five years is not merely administrative-it is value-driven, community-focused, and impact-oriented.

1. Humble Beginnings: From Informal Leadership to Structured Coordination

In **July 2020**, SURE ProEd began with just a handful of devoted individuals, driven by the love for sharing knowledge, and the passion to uplift unemployed rural youth. The management style in the initial days was informal. There were no hierarchies, no official departments - just **pure service spirit**, a shared vision, and daily teamwork.

• Employability Enhancement: The Early Phase

In its initial three years, SURE ProEd began its mission of enhancing employability through a 4-month training program with three students, three courses and three trainers as an offline initiative. This training focused on industry-relevant skills that are often missing from traditional college curricula but are crucial for securing employment. It marked the beginning of a structured effort to bridge the gap between academic learning and real-world job requirements.

• Hands-on Leadership and Grassroots Involvement

From the very beginning, leadership at SURE ProEd was not distant or administrative-it was deeply hands-on. The founders and early volunteers were directly involved in every aspect of the initiative. They personally conducted training sessions, mentored students, reached out to educational institutions, and designed certificates. Their active engagement set the tone for a culture of selfless service, dedication, and a deep commitment to student success.

• WhatsApp Groups as the Nerve Centre

In the early stages, WhatsApp served as the primary coordination and communication platform. Despite its limitations in terms of number of participants permitted, data management and reach, it was used effectively to create class groups, share updates, assign tasks, solve student queries, conduct training sessions and coordinate activities among the team. The simplicity and accessibility of WhatsApp allowed the teams to stay connected across locations, making it a crucial tool even in the initial phase of growth as it is now.

• Manual Efforts by a Close-Knit Team

All aspects of the initiative-from curriculum design, content creation, and scheduling sessions to delivering technical training-were carried out manually by a small but dedicated group of volunteers. This core team worked tirelessly, often late into the night, to ensure that each student received high-quality learning experiences. Without the use of automated tools or

external support, they built the foundation of a movement that would go on to transform thousands of lives. The personal touch and collaborative spirit of this early team remain at the heart of SURE ProEd's ethos even today.

While this model brought flexibility and strong personal bonds, it also posed challenges as the number of students and volunteers began to grow.

2. Organic Growth Leading to Organized Management

As the scale of operations expanded-with thousands of students enrolling in multiple internship batches-it became necessary to **streamline the management and delegate responsibilities** for sustained efficiency.

Key steps in this evolution included:

a) Formation of Core teams

To divide responsibilities and promote focused execution, core teams were created:

• Enrollment Management Team

Responsible for creating whatsapp course groups and sending initial email communication with the respective course Whatsapp group link.

• Training & Curriculum Committee

Responsible for designing course content, onboarding trainers, and maintaining training standards.

• Classes Management Team

Share google meet links for classes, track student participation, discipline management, monitor daily updates, and handle removals in case of non-compliance.

• Certificate & Documentation Team

Issues certificates, maintains student records, ensures accuracy and timely delivery.

• Outreach and Publicity Team

Manages social media, newsletters, event coverage, and liaising with AICTE and other platforms.

• Tech & Website Team

Maintains the SURE ProEd website designing, developing, upgrading and regular management.

• Technical Tools Management Team

This team is responsible for setting up GitHub repositories for every student who joins the internship. They also provide guidance and support in helping students push their project work and related code to their respective repositories, ensuring smooth version control and project documentation.

• Community Services Management Team

This team oversees the coordination of the three mandatory community service activities that each student must complete. They provide clear instructions, track participation, and collect photographs as proof of involvement. These images are then uploaded to the SURE ProEd website for official documentation and public reference.

b) Introduction of Daily Reporting Systems

The introduction of Google Sheets-based daily update systems brought accountability:

- Students were required to submit daily progress of their final project work updates by 11:30 PM. Assigned student coordinators, Charan Sai ensures compliance and followed up with non-responding students.
- Performance tracking tools helped identify sincere learners and those needing intervention.

3. Role of Key Individuals in Strengthening Management

The evolution in SURE ProEd's management has been powered by **dedicated individuals** who took up responsibilities beyond expectations:

- **SURE ProEd Trustees** As the founders and guiding forces, trustees have not only inspired the entire vision but have been the backbone of coordination, student communication, and growth planning.

 - Sri. Ryan Ebenezer, Sri. Anurag Midha & Sri. Satish Ryan Ebenezer, Sri. Anurag Midha, and Sri. Satish devarapally, have each played pivotal roles in shaping the VLSI curriculum. Sri. Ryan introduced the VLSI Front-end program to SURE ProEd, and has mentored hundreds of aspiring engineers. Building on this foundation, Sri. Anurag Midha developed the current, one-of-a-kind 6-month integrated VLSI design course-unique in India. He was ably supported by Sri. Satish from Apple, who coordinates internal training efforts, with additional backing from an exceptional team of professionals from leading companies such as AMD, Synopsys, Intel, and Samsung, to name a few.
 - Harsh Mangalam, Ram Uchit, and Kuldeep These dedicated young individuals have been selflessly managing the SURE ProEd website, ensuring its technical stability and smooth functioning even as the organization scaled up significantly. Their behind-the-scenes efforts have been critical in maintaining a strong online presence and supporting the Trust's expanding digital needs.
 - Anjineyulu, Preethi Grace, and Charan Sai This committed team has played a vital role in maintaining discipline and structure within the learning environment. They implemented and enforced a rigorous daily project tracking mechanism that has greatly improved accountability among interns. Their consistent efforts have ensured that non-responsive participants are identified and filtered out, thereby upholding the quality and commitment expected at SURE ProEd.
 - Sri. Dev Chadha and Abhinav Kapur With the support of a dedicated group of student volunteers-including Abhiram, Boya Yerrisamy, Tanvi, Rishika, Anand Singh, Komal, Ganesh, and Yashwanth, to name a few-are leading the SURE ProEd production department with great efficiency. Their collective work ensures the timely publication of the Trust's monthly newsletters and the smooth, professional operation of the SURE ProEd YouTube channel, which continues to grow in reach and impact.

Sailaja and Prajwala, with the support of Bhargavesh-a student-turned-trainer who
developed automation code for generating certificates and offer letters-ensure that the
entire process runs smoothly and that certificates are issued without any delays or
errors.

These individuals, along with countless student volunteers, reflect the **self-governance model** of SURE ProEd-where leadership is not about titles, but about commitment and service.

4. Digital Transformation and Data-Driven Decisions

With increasing operations, manual management became inefficient. SURE ProEd adapted to digital tools for better scalability:

- **GitHub Integration**: Compulsory for all technical courses, allowing code submissions, version tracking, and collaborative project work.
- **Performance Dashboards**: To monitor student engagement, assignment submission rates, trainer feedback, and course outcomes.
- Newsletter and Communication Channels: Monthly reports, success stories, and announcements keep stakeholders informed and inspired.

This digital transformation has enabled data-driven decision-making, timely interventions, and better resource utilization.

The Internship Model of SURE ProEd

Introduction: A Vision Rooted in Service and Skill

SURE ProEd stands as a beacon of hope, empowerment, and transformation for educated yet unemployed rural youth across India. Built on the foundational vision of upskilling the underprivileged in emerging technologies completely free of cost, SURE ProEd is making meaningful strides in reducing unemployment and bridging the technical skill gap in the country.

Today, SURE ProEd is not just an initiative-it is a movement of committed professionals, inspired youth, and collective action that is addressing a pressing national need: equipping students with industry-ready skills while nurturing their sense of social responsibility.

1. Internship Programs in Emerging Technologies


At the heart of SURE ProEd's work is its flagship initiative-six-month online internship programs designed to train students in over 25 industry-relevant technologies, aligning with the rapidly evolving needs of the technology and education sectors.

These programs cater to students pursuing or recently graduating in engineering, technology, computer science, and related domains, with a special emphasis on rural and under-resourced learners. The courses are designed and taught only by experienced industry professionals, many of whom are employed with top companies and volunteer their time with passion and purpose.

2. Structure of the Internship Program

Each six-month internship offered by SURE ProEd is meticulously designed to provide a comprehensive, hands-on, and structured learning experience, ensuring students are not just passive learners but active problem-solvers.

The internship is divided into two distinct phases:



a) 4-Months Training Phase

- This phase focuses on learning the application of tools, languages, and frameworks specific to the chosen technology domain.
- Students are introduced to industry-standard tools through live online classes and practical sessions.
- They work on mini projects that reinforce each learning module, giving them the confidence to implement their knowledge in real-time settings.
- Dedicated trainers and mentors guide students through structured assignments and periodic evaluations.



b) 2-Months Capstone Project Phase

- Students form small teams or work individually on capstone projects, replicating real-world industry scenarios.
- These projects are problem-solving oriented, with an emphasis on design thinking, coding standards, optimization, and documentation.
- Weekly follow-up sessions ensure project tracking, and mentors provide reviews, feedback, and guidance.


By the end of this phase, students have a portfolio-worthy project they can showcase to potential employers.

3. Evaluation System to Ensure Quality and Accountability

One of the distinguishing features of SURE ProEd's internship model is its rigorous and transparent evaluation system, designed to promote commitment, consistency, and accountability among students.

- The total evaluation score is 100 marks, divided as:
 - 40 marks for mini projects during the first 4 months.
 - o 60 marks for the final capstone project during the last 2 months.
- These marks are then converted into a 10-point GPA scale.
- To be eligible for a completion certificate, a student must score a minimum GPA of 4.0.
- Evaluations are based on project quality, participation, GitHub submissions, and mentor feedback, making the process fair, merit-based, and holistic.
- Capstone project evaluations are conducted by senior industry experts who are independent of the trainer responsible for the four-month instructional period.

This scoring system encourages continuous performance, rather than end-of-program cramming, preparing students for real workplace expectations.

4. Non-Technical Requirements: Building Socially Responsible Technologists

Life Skill Training Wing

Life skill is a term used to describe a set of basic skills acquired either through learning or by direct life experience. This enables individuals and groups to effectively handle issues and problems commonly encountered in daily life. They include creativity, critical thinking, problem-solving, decision-making, the ability to communicate and collaborate, along with personal and social responsibility that contribute to wholesome wellbeing of an individual.

Life Skill Ideation

SURE ProEd was initially founded to empower rural educated unemployed youth by bridging the gap between knowledge acquired at the university and skills required by the industries in a dynamic environment. To address this issue certain technical courses such as AI, Python, Machine Learning, Project Management, Power BI, to name a few, were launched. Over time, these courses exponentially grew to 30+ in number, catering to different needs of the industry. However, some of us felt, mere technical or academic knowledge does not make an individual wholesome. There is a dire need to unleash the latent potential of a student in terms of strong value system and inherent skills. Every student is unique regardless of what background he/she comes from or what qualifications they have secured during their undergrad program. It is to tap and elicit this 'uniqueness' in them and nurture it, we decided to launch 'Life Skills Training Sessions'. They now become an asset to their company and community.

Where we stand Currently

Currently we have about 500+ students attending life skills training sessions. It is a mandatory session, if absent could cost them from being debarred from the institution itself. This year we have increased the duration of the LST session to 1.5-2 hours fortnightly. We engage a guest speaker besides a regular mentor for the concerned module. We also involve current and alumni students to speak on the same topic or any topic that inspires them to share with their peers. Recently, we have launched a channel for SURE ProEd. Under this channel, there would be a series of podcasts dedicated entirely for LST sessions where serious attempts would be made by mentors, advisors, guest speakers & trustees to address pressing problems of our youth who are victims of mental health disorders and depression. These podcasts would be in the form of short snippets ranging from 2 mins to max 10 mins audio-visuals.

Life Skill Modules

Owing to the importance attached to 'LIFE SKILLS', the stakeholders at SURE ProEd decided to give a neat structure to it by drafting a course content. After extensive brainstorming, we came out with the following 8 main modules to deliver the curriculum:

Yoga is derived from the word YUJ meaning Unity. Body, mind and spirit are like a tripod – even if one aspect is not functioning properly, our life will not be balanced and that will lead to ill health. We are very lucky to have Rakshita as a mentor for delivering the program for yoga.

Yoga is one among the six schools of Philosophy (Shad-darshanas). In recent times, though it falls under the category of philosophy, yogic techniques have shown a strong scientific basis for their

practice. Yoga, as defined by Maharshi Patanjali, is disciplining one's mind by regulating the various modifications of the mind (Yogah chitta vritti nirodah, Patanjali Yoga Sutra, Chapter 1.2). The objective of Yoga is integration and inclusion. Integration of the mind and the body, integration of thoughts and actions, integration of an individual (Jeevatma) and the Universe (Paramatma). Yoga in general can help a person maintain good physical fitness, gain mental clarity, achieve emotional balance and more but only with discipline, efforts and practice. In students, yoga can be introduced at early years which will form an integral part of their future lifestyle. This is the best age to mould the young minds through yoga, helping them in their overall personality development. In recent times children are invariably exposed to state-of-the-art technology and a competitive atmosphere resulting in the onset of various physical and psychological problems at an young age. Most common issues observed in school-going children are: Incorrect posture, short attention span, Poor memory, Behavioural disorders, Emotional disturbances, Depression and anxiety.

These can be corrected through the practice of Yoga asanas, Pranayama, Relaxation techniques, meditation, chanting, yogic games etc., Asanas like Tadasana, Vrikshasana, Garudasana, Padahastasana, Padmasana, Ushtrasana, Paschimottanasana, Shirsasana, Sarvangasana and Pranayamas including Nadishodhana and Bramhari, Trataka – a kriya, can improve concentration and enhance memory. Surya Namaskara, trikonasana, Gomukhasana etc., are also beneficial for the overall health of children. Yoga can improve ones creativity, cognitive functions and provide better coping mechanisms especially during exams. Let us not forget Yoga also includes Yama (social discipline) and Niyama (Personal discipline) as primary limbs which help instil morals, values and contribute to a well rounded life of a student.





My name is Jasdeep Singh Hanspal, and I've had the privilege of working as a MERN Stack Instructor at SURE ProEd, where I have successfully led multiple batches through an intensive, hands-on journey in full stack web development. My role at SURE ProEd has been one of both responsibility and immense personal growth, as I took on the challenge of equipping students with one of today's most in-demand technical skill sets-MongoDB, Express.js, React.js, and Node.js, collectively known as the MERN stack.

When I began teaching at SURE ProEd, I was driven by a singular vision: to ensure that students walk away not just with theoretical knowledge, but with the ability to build real-world applications from the ground up. Over time, I meticulously designed and refined the course content to strike a balance between foundational concepts and modern, industry-relevant practices. I started each batch with strong fundamentals in JavaScript, ensuring that learners built a solid base before moving into more complex topics like asynchronous programming, RESTful APIs, component-based architecture in React, and backend integration using Express and MongoDB.

Teaching at SURE ProEd required more than just subject matter expertise-it demanded empathy, adaptability, and the ability to keep students engaged through every phase of the learning process. I made it a point to ensure that my sessions were interactive and student-driven. Whether it was through live coding demonstrations, Q&A-driven discussions, debugging exercises, or project reviews, I created an environment where students could learn by doing. Similarly, while teaching backend development, I guided students through building RESTful APIs and connected them to front-end interfaces to help them grasp the full flow of a web application.

These projects, often built in teams, allowed learners to consolidate their understanding of the MERN stack while tackling real-world challenges such as user authentication,


